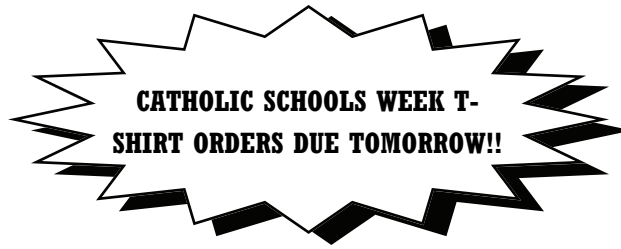


**Join CTK for a Little Italian and a LOT of fun!**
