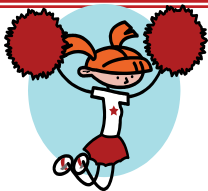
ELECTRONIC BONANZA GREAT SUCCESS!

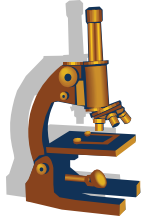
