- Sign on to <https://instantalert.honeywell.com>
- If you have registered previously, simply enter your username and password under "user login".
- If you forgot your password, please enter your User Name and click 'Forgot Password'
- If you are having difficulties, please request assistance by clicking '[Help Request](#)'
- If you have not registered with Honeywell before, simply click 'parent' under New User and follow instructions. You will need to choose 'Christ the King School' from the pull down menu and then enter your child's name and birthday in the indicated field.
- Please note: You will be asked to select which alert types you would like to receive on which contact device. E-mail attachments will be sent as "general" alerts. You may wish to receive these announcements only by e-mail and not by phone.
